



Step by step legal requirements to set up Veterinary x-ray practice in Queensland.

1. Apply for Possession Licence (direct radiography) for the practice.
2. Submit a Radiation Safety and Protection Plan for Veterinary practice together with point 1. This is a comprehensive document that details your legal radiation obligation for safe use practice.
3. Submit Approval to Acquire form for X-ray apparatus. This form details the type of radiation apparatus you will be acquiring.
4. Shielding design for your Veterinary radiation premises.
5. Certificate of compliance PR100:2010 for your Veterinary premises (before use and every 5 years thereafter) after construction.
6. Certificate of compliance NM003:2010 for your x-ray apparatus (before use and every 3 years thereafter) after installation.
