



## Step by step legal requirements to set up Computed Tomography (CT) premises in Queensland.

1. Apply for Possession Licence (diagnostic CT) for the practice
2. Submit a Radiation Safety and Protection Plan for diagnostic medical imaging together with point 1. This is a comprehensive document that details your legal radiation obligation for safe use practice.
3. Submit Approval to Acquire form for CT apparatus. This form details the type of CT radiation apparatus you will be acquiring.
4. Shielding design for your CT radiation premises
5. Certificate of compliance PR100:2010 for your CT premises (before use and every 5 years thereafter)
6. Certificate of compliance HR003:2010 for your CT radiation apparatus (before use and every 3 years thereafter)
