



Step by step legal requirements to set up Cone Beam CT premises in South Australia

1. Apply for Registration Licence (CBCT) for the practice
http://www.epa.sa.gov.au/xstd_files/Radiation/Form/radiation_lic32.pdf
2. Shielding design for your extra oral Cone Beam radiation premises to EPA SA standards. They must include
 - details of constructions and shielding in walls, floors and doors
 - shielding calculations
 - detailed floor plans and surrounding room
3. Performance testing of x-ray apparatus to EPA SA requirements (upon registration and every 1 year for maintenance and checks)
4. Verification of premises shielding as per report when testing x-ray apparatus to EPA SA requirements (upon registration and every 1 year for maintenance and checks)
5. The supplier/installer must notify EPA SA of the sale and installation using the following form
