



## Step by step legal requirements to set up Intra, Extra Oral and CBCT Dental premises in Tasmania

1. Apply for Possession Licence for the practice

2. Submit a Radiation Management Plan

3. Shielding design for the radiation premises in accordance to Radiation Protection Regulations 2006
4. Issue Certificates of Compliance for premises (initially and in event of room changes and surrounding)
5. Performance and Acceptance testing for x-ray apparatus in accordance to RPA0301 (intra oral) and RPA0302 (extra oral) of Tasmania Radiation Apparatus Standard
