



Step by step legal requirements to set up Cabinet/Inspection x-ray premises in Queensland.

1. Apply for Possession Licence (cabinet inspection) for the practice
2. Submit a Radiation Safety and Protection Plan for cabinet inspection together with point 1. This is a comprehensive document that details your legal radiation obligation for safe use practice.
3. Submit Approval to Acquire form for the x-ray apparatus. This form details the type cabinet inspection radiation apparatus you will be acquiring (to be completed between client and x-ray machine supplier).
4. Shielding design for your radiation premises
5. Certificate of compliance NM002:2010 for your x-ray cabinet inspection apparatus (before use and every 3 years thereafter)
6. If the x-ray apparatus is in an enclosed unit, there is no premises certification required
