



Step by step legal requirements to set up Intra, Extra Oral and CBCT dental premises in Australia Capital Territory

1. Apply for Registration Licence for the practice

2. Submit a Radiation Safety and Management Plan for the practice together with point 1. This is a comprehensive document that details your legal radiation obligation for safe use practice.
3. Shielding design for the practice radiation premises. The report must be submitted together with point 1 above.
4. Performance and Acceptance testing for x-ray apparatus, report to be submitted to ACT Radiation Health.
